Children's Book Awards Quiz



Year 7 & 8s—Make up a school team—Test your reading recall and be part of the eighth annual Tararua District Library NZ Children's Book Awards Quiz. There will be prizes and a trophy for the overall Tararua District winning team.

- WHEN: Wednesday 16 August 2017 at 6:30pm
- WHERE: Your local Community Library
- REGISTRATION: due by 5:00pm Friday 04 August 2017

Questions are based on the finalists in the 2017 New Zealand Book Awards for Children and Young Adults in the Picture Book, Junior Fiction, Junior Non-Fiction and Illustration categories. The covers of these are displayed on the reverse of the entry form.

Every year, libraries throughout NZ celebrate the New Zealand Book Awards for Children and Young Adults. This year we will hold our annual quiz for the eighth time.

The event is run simultaneously at Dannevirke, Woodville, Pahiatua and Eketahuna libraries, dependant on entry numbers.

There are five questions per book, per category. Non-fiction book questions are based on the first 10 pages only, which may include publishing information. In the event of a tie after four rounds, another set of 5 questions will be asked of the tied teams. This will continue until a winning team is found.

PRIZES

Teams of four (or less) will compete to be named the **New Zealand Children's Book Awards District Champions**. The winners will hold the trophy for a year, plus be awarded a prize. The highest scoring team in each of the other towns will receive a small prize too.
